#### Vanda Ralevska FRPS

Vanda is a landscape photographer living in London, UK. Her interest in photography was sparked in her teens and is now an inseparable part of her life. "I am passionate about capturing the world we live in, always searching for those fleeting moments of magic that transform it into something extraordinary".

Having grown up in an industrial area of former Czechoslovakia, Vanda soon learnt how to appreciate the beauty of the natural world, far away from the big city. Nowadays she finds most inspiration in quieter scenes and intimate details, whether it is on the coast, in woodland, in the countryside, or even in cities, during quiet times.

Vanda is a Kase Filters Ambassador, a member of Arena Photographers group, and has been a Landscape Photographer of the Year Judge for four years running. She regularly gives lectures at photographic clubs and events in the UK and abroad, hoping to inspire others to find their own style, to look beyond the obvious, and to find joy while doing so.

#### **Geraint Radford**

Geraint is a professional wildlife macro photographer and tutor, an insect's best friend, vegan and cake addict. He is also an OM SYSTEM Ambassador.

Growing up in the beautiful Welsh Valleys his days were often spent exploring and searching for bugs and other mini beasts. This is where he found his deep love and appreciation of nature and wildlife. In 2010 he began his journey into the world of photography and a year later he was a commercial photographer with a wide range of clients. But in 2016 he decided to follow his heart and became a full-time Nature Photographer specialising in insect photography.

Macro photography is his way of sharing with others the amazing creatures and plant life that often go overlooked and he does so with the welfare of the subject as a priority. All his subjects are photographed as and where they are found with no physical manipulation or harm.

Geraint's photographs have been used by the BBC and can be seen in photographic magazines and online articles. He featured in a BBC news piece showcasing his love for the macro world. His work is featured in Exhibitions and he loves to chat about photography and his subjects.

In 2023, Geraint was "Runner up" in the Botanical Britain category of the British Wildlife Photography Awards. He received highly commended awards in both 2016 and 2017 in Outdoor Photographer of The Year's "Small World" category. His images were published in portfolio books and his photographs displayed at the prestigious Photography Show at the NEC where he presented in 2021 and 2022.

Geraint uses the OM system OM-1 combined with the OM System 90mm Macro lens, and an Olympus Fl900r with a Cygnustech diffuser. He believes this is the perfect combination for macro photography "Lightweight, weather sealed gear that enhances my time in nature, along with wicked cool features such as focus stacking - lets me capture images of a world that I love, and importantly, I have a lot of fun using this equipment".

Multi Award winning Bristol - based photographer and actor Bill Ward, best known for playing the badly behaved builder Charlie Stubbs in Coronation Street and the long suffering farmer James Barton in Emmerdale, will give a very personal insight into his unique photographic journey.

He will discuss his background - starting in the Advertising Industry and a successful career at some of the UK's top Agencies (including BBH, Saatchi and Saatchi) before starting his Acting career. He will go on to share the photographs he takes and why he takes them - all are very closely related.

He will reveal the full range of his work, from his contemporary Seascapes, Landscapes and Cityscapes, to his distinctive "Creative Photography" projects (ICM, In-camera Multiple Exposures, and Abstract) - a genre in which he has been a leading practitioner for over a decade. Expect plenty of unexpected twists and turns, and an awful lot of pictures!

Bill won the Adobe Prize at UK Landscape Photographer of the Year 2015, Best Seascape at Scottish Landscape Photographer of the Year 2020, and is delighted to be on the judging panel for UK Landscape Photographer of the Year for both 2022 and 2023.

He is an Ambassador for Pentax Ricoh UK, a Tour/Workshop Leader for Light and Land, and shoots for the photographic agencies Robert Harding and ArenaPal."

#### **Blair Jones**

Blair is a Gwent based birder, photographer, and drone pilot. He is passionate about Gwent Wildlife and the Newport Wetlands Reserve, particularly the Goldcliff Lagoons. Blair is an amateur photographer, self-taught, having no formal photography training and has learned his craft pretty much through trial and error.

Blair is well known in Gwent and wider afield for his blog named The Wildlife Oculus. The blog was created in July 2017 after he suffered from optic neuropathy and lost more than seventy percent of his sight in his left eye resulting in him having to adapt significantly at the time. Thankfully he has overcome most of the issues and has become a prolific photographer.

Blair likes to use his photographs to complement the stories he writes and he hopes very much to share with his audience his love of the Natural world and photography.

Two years ago Blair purchased his first Unmanned Aerial Vehicle aka "Drone" - it opened up a whole new world of opportunities and perspectives. Since then, he has acquired another drone and undertaken A2 Certificate of Competence training to become a CAA Certified remote pilot.

Blair has had his photographic work published by Newspapers, Wildlife organizations and Charity groups. In recent years he has been involved with Media projects such as Story Trails Newport and the Myfanwy Haycock Poetry Trail.
