AWARDS FOR PHOTOGRAPHIC MERIT – NOVEMBER 2023 ADJUDICATION

It was another successful APM Adjudication weekend with the Print entries being assessed at The Jubilee Hotel, Nottingham on Saturday 25 November and the Projected Digital Images at Smethwick Clubrooms on Sunday 26November.

There were 9 entrants in the first ever Badge (BPAGB) Print section and 8 were successful. 27 entrants in the Credit (CPAGB) Print section with 20 successful and in the Credit PDI, out of 25 entrants 19 were successful. In the Distinction (DPAGB) Print category there were 17 entrants with 6 successful, whilst in Distinction PDI there were 20 entrants with 8 successful. In the new Excellence (EPAGB) Print category there were 10 entrants with 5 successful and in the Master (MPAGB) Print, out of 7 entrants, 4 photographers gained the Award.

We are indebted to the North & East Midlands Photographic Federation for their hard work in organising the Print event, Carol Cheetham the Organising & Reception Secretary, N&EMPF President, Sue Wilson, Print Handlers Steve Walters, Louse & Gary Langley, Brian & Shirley Davis, Peter Jones and Dave Severn, who was also resident Photographer for both venues. The event ran very smoothly. Thank you all.

We also thank Smethwick Photographic Society for hosting the PDI event on the Sunday, led by Judith & Roger Parry, together with members of Smethwick Photographic Society. We thank you all for your welcome and hospitality.

Our grateful thanks also go to the Adjudicators Dave Gibbins, Richard Speirs, Gordon Jenkins, Jane Lines, Carol McNiven Young and Mike Sharples, who worked hard over the weekend assessing the bumper entry.







The new Levels were well supported with nine Applicants for the Badge Award (BPAGB) and ten for the Excellence Award (EPAGB). The procedures worked well and, although there were obvious logistical problems to be overcome, the Print handling and judging went well. Congratulations to everyone who was successful and commiserations to those who were less fortunate.

The trial will continue to the next Adjudication in April 2024 and is likely that these Awards will become a permanent feature for Print applications. The organising committee have doubts about these new levels being appropriate for PDI applications and, if you have views, please make them known to your Federation who can bring them to the PAGB Executive.

We are delighted with the new BPAGB badge, which many think is the most elegant of the series, but we are disappointed with the EPAGB Badge and are looking to source a different design. The badges presented to the recently successful EPAGB applicants could become a truly unique prize.
